Fairtrade Renewal





Community Centre - Update

The design consultation event held during July & August this year highlighted some areas for further review, namely the external appearance of the building. The architects have since prepared revised plans addressing some of the key themes. Town Councillors considered the Consultation Report and revised plans at a Planning Committee meeting on 4th September, following which at a meeting of the Full Council on 18th September approved a preferred option, which will now be submitted to Teignbridge District Council for planning approval.

Dog Survey

Bovey Tracey Town Council is calling on, and actively encouraging, local residents to take part in a council survey aimed at tackling dog problems at the Recreation Ground, Bovey Tracey

Dog fouling and dogs on leads has been a major concern for councillors in Bovey Tracey. For a number of years now, the town council called for dogs to be on leads at the Recreation Ground in an attempt to mitigate the issue of dog fouling in an area used largely for other sports. Unfortunately, however, the advisory signage is ignored by many and at a council's Recreation Parks & Property Committee meeting in October, there was a call from some Councillors to ban dogs completely from this area.

The consultation is about seeking powers from a new Public Spaces Protection Order. Questions seek residents' views around a complete dog ban or whether dogs should continue to be able to access the Recreation Ground, but kept on leads at all times.

The Council is fully aware that the majority of dog owners are responsible and continue to respect the area, however the results of the consultation will be used to decide future action to be taken to make sure that the Recreation Ground in Bovey Tracey is fit for purpose for every person and group that uses it.
