Devon Air Ambulance – Night Landing Site

Planning Permission has recently been granted for the installation of a Lighting Column to enable night time landing at the Recreation Ground by Devon Air Ambulance.

The Town Council has been awarded a grant, match funded by Devon Air Ambulance, which will fully fund the purchase and supply costs of the lighting column. This will be operated remotely by the Helicopter Emergency Medical Services, to facilitate emergency night operations. Thank you goes to Bovey Tracey Swimming Pool Trust who have agreed to allow an electricity supply to be taken from the pool premises for the lighting column.

Community Centre - Update



During the summer recess period, the Council was delighted to receive confirmation that a grant of £82,880.00 has been awarded to the project from the Greater Dartmoor Leaf programme, in addition approval has been given by the Secretary of Housing, Communities and Local Government for Council borrowing up to £500,000 to part fund the development costs. The Council now awaits the second stage tender submission from the Main Building Contractor whilst the design team work on the discharge of Planning Conditions, which includes the need for undertaking additional archaeological investigations prior to work commencing on site.

The more obvious addition at Station Road Car Park is the delivery of a portacabin which will provide temporary accommodation for the Information Centre to continue to operate, enabling the service to free-up their existing cabin in readiness for development to commence.

The responses were independently analysed by Catalyst, and their report has been on the Town Council website and in the library since July.

A Vision for Bovey Tracey

Your survey responses gave the Steering Group (SG) clear guidelines as to how you want the Parish to be, both now and in the future. A draft Vision statement has been drawn up for you to consider and comment on.

Objectives

With the help of community volunteers, the SG studied the results of the March survey and considered what could be realistically attained. They have developed draft objectives for you to comment on in this consultation.
